Ethics

Ethics can be define as "the branch of philosophy dealing with standards of conduct and moral judgement."

Ethics is concerned what ought to be, what is right or wrong, good or bad. medical ethics is the branch of ethics that deals with moral issues in medical practice.

Introduction to pharmaceutical jurisprudence.

forensic pharmacy or pharmaceutical jurisprudence is that branch of pharmacy which deals with various legislation related to drugs and pharmaceutical and profession of pharmacy.

The words forensic is derived from Latin term forensic means a "in open court" or public place from interaction or deliberation. jurisprudence means study of fundamental laws and because of pharmaceutical jurisprudence it is law relating to pharmacy. jurisprudence derived from two words -

juris - law

prudentia - wisdom / knowledge
philosophy / science.

History of drugs legislation in India

The government of India in pursuance of the resolution appointed a committee known as the drug inquiry committee in 1928.

The Indian journal of pharmacy was started by professor M.L. Shroff in 1939.

All India pharmaceutical congress associated in 1940.

The pharmaceutical conference held its sessions at different places to publicise pharmacy as a whole. The government of India on 11 August 1930 appointed a committee under the chairmanship of late (Colonial) Col. R.N. Chopra to see in to the problems of pharmacy in India and recommended the measures to be taken.
